Jacangelo elected to the Board of Directors of National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence

MERCERVILLE ... (June 27, 2002) - The National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence-New Jersey (NCADD-NJ) has named Joseph Jacangelo, a lifelong educator, to its Board of Directors. Jacangelo recently retired as assistant superintendent of schools in the Caldwell/West Caldwell School District, having spent 39 years in public education. He currently serves as board president of the Bridge, an alcohol and drug counseling agency.

In addition to his position with the Bridge, Jacangelo is the treasurer of the Essex Valley School for emotionally disturbed high school students, with which he has been affiliated for 23 years. He is the director of UNICO, a service organization dedicated to supporting the handicapped, youth projects, scholarships and civic volunteers.

Over the course of his career, Janangelo was a principal at the elementary, middle school, junior high school and high school levels. He also officiated football for 27 years at the high school and college levels. He remains involved in teaching as a supervisor of student teachers at Caldwell College and Montclair State University. He and his wife, Sandra, have a daughter, Michele, and live in Parsippany.

NCADD-NJ is a private, nonprofit public health agency that promotes the prevention and treatment of, and recovery from, alcoholism and drug dependence through advocacy and education. The agency develops and promotes public policy initiatives and advocates for legislation and regulations that are in keeping with a public health approach to the diseases of alcoholism and drug dependence. Terms on the organization's 11-member board range from one to three years.
